Dear readers,

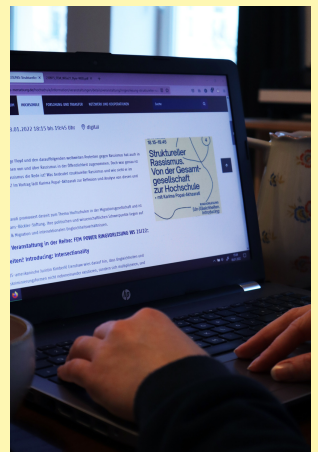

There is even a tendency to regress in equality. In science, for example, fewer assigned-female-at-birth individuals published during the pandemic because of the extra care work they performed. For assigned-male-at birth individuals, publication volume increased because of the lack of possible activities. Studies like this one on gender and corona are summarized on the FEM POWER Saxony-Anhalt page.
